SERVICE FEES

Our Professional Service Fee incorporates all of the tasks and services involved in arranging, co-ordinating and conducting a funeral; this may include but is not limited to; guidance and care from experienced, professionally trained staff (available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year), co-ordinating the initial transfer from the place of death, provision of mortuary care with experienced and qualified mortuary staff, provision of our complete facilities at the funeral centre for consultation/viewing/ funerals, hearse and 4 seat mourning coach (if required), provision of necessary staff, placement of funeral notices in the newspaper, liasing and making arrangements with; cemetery and/or crematorium, clergy or a civil celebrant, florist, caterer, musician and other service providers.

\$2420 **Direct Cremation**

Cremation and cemetery fees, and all other disbursements are additional

Inclusive of transfer of deceased, coffin provided, no selection offered. No funeral or mourners in attendance.

Essential Care Service

A basic funeral service used to assist families to reduce funeral costs. It does not include mortuary care and attendance for viewing fee, memorial attendance book, mourning car, a video recording of the service or the use of our centre for either the funeral service or refreshments. These items are available at additional costs.

Cremation - Ballarat Crematorium Chapel only.	\$265

Traditional Single Service \$3550

A funeral service and committal conducted at one venue, usually associated with cremations. The service may be conducted at the church of your choice, Ballarat Crematorium Chapel or the Doveton Park Funeral Centre with mourners not having to relocate for a committal service.

Traditional Dual Service

Funeral service conducted at the church of your choice or the Doveton Park Funeral Centre followed by a committal service at the graveside or crematorium. Alternatively the burial or cremation may be attended by family either before or after a memorial service.

Memorial Service \$2100

Memorial service conducted at the church of your choice or the Doveton Park Funeral Centre where there is no requirement for Peter Tobin Funerals to attend to the deceased. For example, where the burial or cremation has already taken place elsewhere by another funeral director or at an earlier date.

Pre Paid Funerals

An administration fee of \$320 will apply to prepaid funerals and funeral bonds.

TRANSFER FEES

Transfer fees are included in our service fees for all transfers that take place between normal business hours and within our operating area (generally a 50 km radius of Ballarat). Transfers outside these times and areas are subject to additional fees.

Funerals conducted outside our normal operating area will also be subject

to transfer and travel fees. After hours transfer \$430 (Outside the hours of 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday) After Hours transfer for Vigil Prayers or Rosary \$430 After hours transfer for Vigil Prayers or Rosary with viewing \$570

MORTUARY AND EMBALMING FEES

The preparation of the body is an important service carried out by the funeral director. Preparation costs are included in our service fees except in the case of Essential Care services where an additional charge is made for those families who choose to arrange a viewing.

FINANCIAL POLICY

We understand that making funeral arrangements can be a difficult task and your family may not be well prepared. Good communication is important between your family and your funeral director with regard to all aspects of a funeral arrangement. Financial arrangements for the services you ask us to render must be mutually agreed upon.

We would be grateful if you would advise us during the funeral arrangements of your situation so that we may be able to determine which option of payment best suits you. Our consultant will provide you with an estimate of our costs together with payments advanced to other parties disbursements for the funeral. Some costs may not be known and may only be included in the final account. The person who signs the authorisation for the funeral is legally responsible for payment of the funeral account, their signature acknowledges this.

The account will be issued one week following the funeral. We ask that the account be settled within 10 days in line with the clearly marked due by date. Interest may be applied to the account after 30 days if payment is delayed. If payments are made by a family member before the estate is finalised, that person will be the first to be reimbursed from the assets before the distribution of the estate. Most banks will pay the funeral account from an account owned by the deceased without Probate being required regardless of the account being 'frozen'.

Our intention is to assist your family in any way we are able. Please advise us if we may be of assistance.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

- Payment of cremation or cemetery fees 24 hours prior to the funeral taking place.
- Payment of the full funeral expenses within 10 days of receipt of the funeral account.

Financial arrangements other than the above must be discussed and agreed upon prior to the conclusion of the funeral arrangements.
